

Year 5: World War One

During the topic we will be focusing on:
Geography, History and Literacy

Our Subject goals:

Geography: Look at the map of Europe and locate countries involved in World War 1.

Compare a map of Europe finding differences between before and after the war.

History: World War 1. Focus on how the war started, what happened during the Christmas truce, look at the impact of conscription in Britain. Understand what rationing was and why it was brought in.

Understand what happened during the Zeppelin raid and the impact it had.

Maths: Converting measurements to work out rationing

Art: Create a poster to help recruit more soldiers. Silhouette art.

Topic Write: Poetry: Write a poem to show what it might have been like to be a soldier in the war.

Music: Learn and perform War time songs

Computing: Create a game using scratch
