Text Types:

What the children will be learning:

In English, we will be writing a descriptive opening, introducing our own islands. We will also be covering persuasive writing, an explanation text and discussion text. We will be developing the skills of:

- Using semicolon, colon and dashes to mark independent clauses.
- Using different ways to start sentences.
- Using different cohesive devices.

In Geography, we'll be learning about:

- How coasts are formed.
- How erosion shapes the coastline.
- Different coastlines in different parts of the world.
- How human activity affects the coastal environment.
- Using a range of maps, including OS maps to study coasts.

In DT, we'll be:

- Using food technology to design and make scones and jam to sell at the summer fete.
- Use appropriate cooking equipment and produce clear instructions to follow.
- Design and make a sand buggy using knowledge of electrical circuits and pulley systems
- Use tools safely to create a chassis for the sand buggy.
